

Terrific Tips for Helpers

Children are active. These cards provide 96 of the most common action words (verbs) to match them. Each card has the word on the front with colorful characters acting it out. The back of the card has the word above and listed in a rhyming sentence.

Start Simple

Start with the verbs verbs that a child hears first (sit, run, walk, eat, and drink) and work on recognizing these words and actions. Add more action words as the child progresses until he or she has learned all of the verbs.

Act It Out

Show the children a card and have them act it out. After they have learned the action words, try the words and see if they can act it out without the picture prompt.
