A Great White Shark's Meal

Watch this video to learn about great white sharks. Why do so many sharks go to this area near the Neptune Islands?

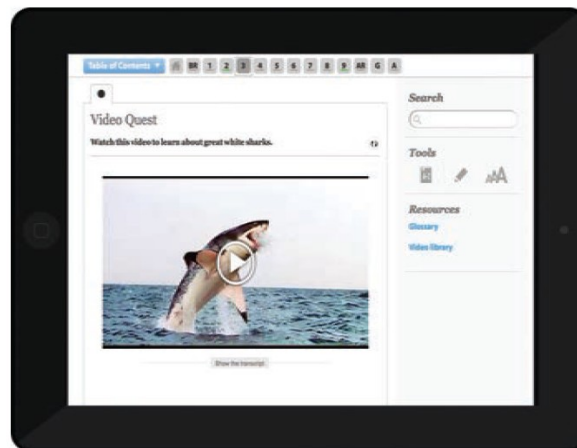
It may seem like 21 kilograms is a lot of food, but it is only about 2 percent of the whale shark's weight. Like people, most species of sharks only eat about 2 percent of their weight a day. That's not very much at all. Seals, one of the shark's prey, eat about 6 percent of their weight, and loons, a type of bird, eat 22 percent of their weight a day!

People think sharks are always eating, but some sharks don't even eat every day. They have a lot of teeth, but they can't chew¹⁾ their food very well, so they have to swallow it in big pieces. Because of that it takes them a long time to digest²⁾ their food. And they have to let it digest before they can eat again.

¹⁾chew: break food between your teeth as a part of eating
²⁾digest: change food in the stomach so the body can use it

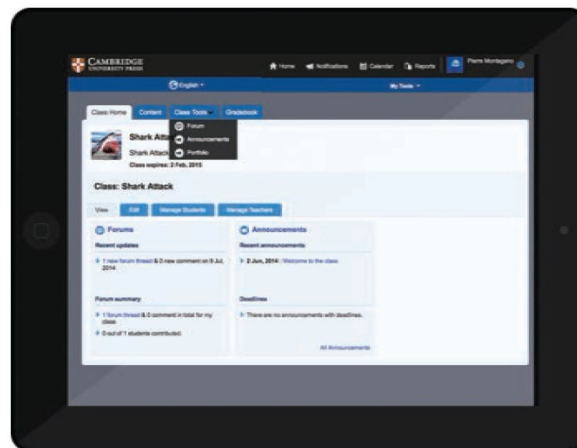
