

Fantastic Mr Fox - Chapter 13-14 Worksheet

Let's learn a little bit about the animals in the story.



Red Fox

The red fox is a carnivore, so it only eats meat.
It has short ears and a long tail.
It has red, white and black fur.
It digs a hole and lives underground.
It usually moves around at night and sometimes in daylight.



Badger

The badger is an omnivore, so it eats meat and plants, too.
It has short ears and a short tail.
It has grey, black and white fur.
It digs a hole and lives underground.
It usually moves around at night.



Rabbit

The rabbit is a herbivore, so it only eats plants.
It has long ears and a short tail.
It has grey or brown fur.
It digs a hole and lives underground.
It usually moves around in daylight.
